



LEGISLATIVE UPDATE 3/16/2007

H.3726, Representative Cato, allows the governing body of a Special Purpose District to voluntarily dissolve itself and transfer its assets and liabilities to a county if accepted by resolution of its governing body. The bill has been referred to the House Labor, Commerce & Industry Committee.

This legislation as currently written, impacts all SPD's regardless of their government structure, financial structure, or what type of services they provide. The bill could very easily become an avenue to do away with SPD's without the members of the district being able to express their opinions and desires. SPD attorney's are currently evaluating this legislation.
