



LEGISLATIVE UPDATE 5/14/2010

H.3603, Rep. M.A. Pitts, this bill provides that if a person pollutes the waters of this state as defined by DHEC, they will give public notice of the pollution in a matter prescribed by DHEC. Also, the committee adopted an amendment that the sewer entity will provide public notice within 48 hours if the spill is 5000 Gallons or greater. The bill was given a favorable report by the Senate Medical Affairs Committee and will now travel to the Senate Floor for debate. ***Please contact your Senator and raise your concerns about this legislation.***

H.3774, Rep. Viers, this bill provides that a city may not require annexation as a condition to provide utility service. The bill was given an unfavorable report by the House Special Laws Subcommittee and will now move forward for debate by the full House Judiciary Committee. The full House Judiciary Committee once again adjourned debate on the bill.

H.3772, Rep. Viers, will allow an SPD to continue providing service following annexation by a city. The bill was given a favorable report by the House Special Laws Subcommittee and will now move forward for debate by the full House Judiciary Committee. The full House Judiciary Committee once again adjourned debate on the bill.
