



LEGISLATIVE UPDATE May 2, 2008

H.4578, Rep. Harrison, is a joint resolution proposing a Constitutional Amendment to authorize the General Assembly, by special or local law, to abolish a Special Purpose District and transfer its assets and liabilities to an assuming service provider. The bill was referred to a Senate Judiciary Subcommittee.

H.4754, Rep. G.R. Smith, the governing body of a special purpose district created by act of the General Assembly that provides only recreational services and has as its boundary the same as the county in which it is located, by resolution, may transfer all of its assets and liabilities to the governing body of a county. The bill remains on the Senate Calendar awaiting second reading. Senate Staff is currently working on proposed amendments.

S.428, Senator Hayes, a bill to enact the SC Water Withdrawal, Permitting, Use, and Reporting Act. The bill is on the Senate Calendar awaiting second reading; however, it does have a minority report indicating in all likelihood it will not pass this year.
