



## ***LEGISLATIVE UPDATE May 30, 2008***

**H.4578, Rep. Harrison,** is a joint resolution proposing a Constitutional Amendment to authorize the General Assembly, by special or local law, to abolish a Special Purpose District and transfer its assets and liabilities to an assuming service provider. The bill was referred to a Senate Judiciary Subcommittee.

**H.4754, Rep. G.R. Smith,** the governing body of a special purpose district created by act of the General Assembly that provides only recreational services and has as its boundary the same as the county in which it is located, by resolution, may transfer all of its assets and liabilities to the governing body of a county. The bill remains on the Senate Calendar awaiting second reading. Senate Staff is currently working on proposed amendments.

**H.3030, Rep. J.R. Smith,** would allow a rural community water district to provide a sewage collection system within the district. The bill is on the Senate calendar awaiting third reading.

**H.4470, Speaker Harrell,** would allow a State Income Tax Credit for the purchase, installation, or improvement of a fire sprinkler system. The bill would also limit charges for separate lines for fire sprinkler systems to actual costs for SPD and City water systems. The bill was given third reading by the Senate.
