



LEGISLATIVE UPDATE 3/12/2010

H.4193, Rep. Cooper, this bill will prohibit a municipality, SPD or county, or unit or agency of it, from imposing a fee or seeking reimbursement of costs or expenses incurred as a result of responding to a motor vehicle accident, except:

- (1) Where the coverage for these services is expressly provided by an insurance company to the insured and the services are billed lawfully to the insured;
- (2) For emergency medical services; or
- (3) For actual hazardous material response, mitigation and clean up.

This bill was recently amended by a House Ways & Means Subcommittee to include SPD's and will now move forward to the full House Ways & Means Committee for debate.

S.1222, Senator Cleary, "The Permit Extension Joint Resolution of 2010", this is a joint resolution to extend, up to 2 years, certain government approvals (DHEC Permitting) affecting the development of real property in the State. The bill was passed by a Senate Judiciary Subcommittee and will now move forward to the full Senate Judiciary Committee for debate. **H.4445** is companion legislation that has passed the House.

S.1241, Senator Cleary (Georgetown), this bill will do various things relating to definitions concerning the authority of county boards. The county boards of several counties of the State are authorized to enlarge, diminish, or consolidate an existing special purpose district located within that county, including a Rural Community Water District and authorize the issuance of general obligation bonds by the special purpose district. The bill was referred to a Senate Judiciary Subcommittee with following **Senate Members: Senator Cleary (Chairman), Senator Robert Ford, and Senator Shane Martin**.

S.1127, Senator Campbell, provides that the standard for dissolved oxygen is 0.1 MG/L (Water & Sewer Districts). The bill received a favorable report from House Agriculture, Natural Resources, & Environmental Affairs Committee and now moves to the House Floor.
