



LEGISLATIVE UPDATE 4/16/2009

H.3774, Rep. Viers, this bill provides that a city may not require annexation as a condition to provide utility service. The bill was given an unfavorable report by the House Special Laws Subcommittee and will now move forward for debate by the full House Judiciary Committee. The full House Judiciary Committee adjourned debate on the bill. **Please continue to contact members of the House Judiciary Committee and ask them to support passage of this legislation.**

H.3772, Rep. Viers, will allow an SPD to continue providing service following annexation by a city. The bill was given a favorable report by the House Special Laws Subcommittee and will now move forward for debate by the full House Judiciary Committee. The full House Judiciary Committee adjourned debate on the bill. **Please continue to contact members of the House Judiciary Committee and ask them to support passage of this legislation.**

H.4806, Rep. Clemmons, The governing body of a municipality, county, school district, or board may adopt a term limit for their respective body or board upon the approval of a two-thirds vote of the members of the body or board. The bill was referred to the House Judiciary Committee.
