



2/18/2011 LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

H.3617, Rep. Pitts, this bill provides that a sewage system or treatment facility that has had three or more sewage spills in a twelve month period must complete a comprehensive review of their operations. After much debate, the Environmental Affairs II Subcommittee adjourned debate on the bill and will discuss it again in approximately two weeks.

H.3470, Rep. Pitts, this bill will add household dishwashing detergents to the cleaning products included in the restriction on phosphates. The House Environmental Affairs II Subcommittee gave the bill a favorable report.

H.3417, Rep. Funderburk, This bill will include emergency medical and rescue response services as an authorized purpose for which an SPD or PSD may be established. The bill was given a favorable report by the full House Judiciary Committee and will now move forward for debate on the House floor.

S.560, Senator Fair, This bill will allow SPD's that provide sanitation services to participate in State Health and Dental Insurance Plans. The bill was referred to the Senate Finance Committee.
